


#### **NEW SOUTH WALES BIRD REPORT FOR 1984**

#### T.R. LINDSEY

This is the fifteenth annual report and covers the period 1 January to 31 December 1984. For this period, just over 200 observers submitted some 3425 observations in addition to many general notes and comments. As before, the chief aims of this report are threefold: to place on record observations of birds accidental or rare in the State; to record observations that delineate with greater precision the normal distribution of birds within the State; and to record observations that may reflect changes in numbers, range or movements. All reports are collated and held on file; those which seem most significant (about 1400) are presented here.

At least one new species was added to the State list during the year when a Black-naped Tern was seen in the far north-east. Two other species — Audubon's and Manx Shearwater — were identified at sea, though the process of vetting these records has not been completed. Otherwise, 1984 appears to have been a ''normal'' year. Broadly speaking, numbers of waterfowl and waders seem to have been about average. Influxes of woodswallows were noted in the far west and lorikeets in the Illawarra, and quails and several other ground birds appear to have been somewhat more numerous than usual, but these appear to have been relatively small-scale events. It is hard to find any indication of significant aberrations in the body of observations received.

Abbreviations are as used in previous reports, and other conventions are as explained in the 1983 Report (Aust. Birds 19: 65-100), including the organization of observations according to 17 State regions (Fig. 1). One popular bird-watching spot falls almost precisely on a boundary between two such regions, causing some difficulties in the allocation of records. According to the system

of region boundaries adopted in these reports, the Shoalhaven River constitutes the southern boundary of the Illawarra region and the southern bank constitutes the northern limit of the South Coast region. Shoalhaven Heads is a small hamlet lying at the mouth of the river on the north bank and is therefore in the Illawarra region; Comerong Island, however – extending as it does from the Shoalhaven south to the Crookhaven River – is clearly in the South Coast region. The geographic ahomaly that causes difficulty is that a sandbank has long since closed off the mouth of the Shoalhaven proper, which now empties into the sea via the Crookhaven. Convenient access to Comerong Island is a short stroll across the sandbar from Shoalhaven Heads. Hence, some observers record their observations almost interchangeably as Shoalhaven Heads or Comerong Island. None of the possible solutions to this anomaly seem entirely satisfactory and observers are therefore urged to be aware of this difficulty and specify accordingly.

The annual Gould League Campout (GLC) was held this year at Mt Murchison homestead some 30 km north-west of Wilcannia. Because this is a sparsely populated and under-reported region of New South Wales, a number of reports of species, even some common birds, have been included.




Fig. 2. Bar charts indicating major trends in reports received for 1984, analysed (a) by taxonomic group (b) by region (see Fig. 1) and (c) by month. In (b) the analysis yields an unsatisfactory figure (1164) for Sydney region because of a very high incidence of duplicate records (sightings independently reported by two or more members of a party of observers) in the data set; a rough manual check suggests the true figure is about 980. Duplicate reporting from other regions was negligible.

#### ADDENDA AND CORRIGENDA, 1983 REPORT

Beach Stone-curlew Esacus magnirostris

It was wrongly implied (p 82) that two separate pairs were involved in breeding attempts at Red Rock: in fact one pair made two successive attempts at nesting. Both failed.

#### SYSTEMATIC LIST

Emu *Dromaius novaehollandiae* Central Tableland: 3 at Goulburn River NP Sep (SH). Northwest Slope: 1 seen 20 km NW of Bonshaw 10 Sep (GH). Upper Western: recorded at Mt Murchison HSD 27 Aug–7 Sep, common; max 34, 1 with 3 chicks, 1 with 11 half-grown young (GLC). Lower Western: hundreds at Coombie HSD near Roto, many breeding (JH).

Great Crested Grebe *Podiceps cristatus*Sydney region: 2 at Lake Gannaway 28 Aug (J&NR); 2 at Penrith Lakes 5 Sep and 22 Dec, bred (RB; ARMcG); max 10 at Bushells Lagoon Nov–Dec (2 in display (TK, IMcA; AMcB). Illawarra: max 66 at Wingecarribee Dam 11 Aug–7 Oct (CC). Northwest Plain: 1 at Whittakers Lagoon W of Moree 22 Apr (JHa). Riverina: many pairs with young at extensive lignum swamp near Booligal 24 Dec (PN&PMM). Lower Western: max 20 + at Imperial Lake (2 pairs bred), Stephens Creek and Umberumberka Reservoirs near Broken Hill Jan–Feb, Sep and Dec (NWSh); 2 at Hollands Lake, Dareton 22 Feb (JNH).

Hoary-headed Grebe *Poliocephalus poliocephalus*Sydney region: pair nesting near Richmond 8 Dec, very small area of water (AMcB). Illawarra: 90 + at Wingecarribee Dam 20 Jul (ARMcG); 30 at Fitzroy Reservoir 2 Sep (CC).

Little Penguin Eudyptula minor Mid-north Coast: nesting at Seal Rocks 3 Aug (JP).

Wandering Albatross *Diomedea exulans* Sydney region: arrival South Head, Sydney Harbour NP 29 Apr (AKM); summer records include 1 seen 10 km off Sydney Heads 24 Nov and 2 off Sydney Heads 15 Dec (AMCB). Illawarra: first seen 3 off Flagstaff Point, Wollongong 1 Jun, common 11 Aug, last seen 25 Nov (CC; IMcA *et al*).

Royal Albatross Diomedea epomophora South Coast: 1 off Green Cape 25 May (TR).

Black-browed Albatross *Diomedea melanophrys*Sydney region: several summer records: 1 derelict at Narrabeen Beach 9 Nov (WEB, IMcA); 1 subadult 10 km off Sydney Heads 24 Nov; 4 (2 ad, 2 imm) off Sydney Heads 15 Dec (AMcB). Illawarra: first seen 1 off Red Point, Port Kembla 21 May (CC); very numerous Aug–Sep (max 150+, ca 75/imm), last seen 25 Nov (CC, AMcB, IMcA et al).

Grey-headed Albatross *Diomedea chrysostoma* Sydney region: 1 juv/imm photographed 12 naut. mls E of Barrenjoey Head, Sydney 5 Nov (NGC).

Yellow-nosed Albatross *Diomedea chlororhynchos*Mid-north Coast: 10+ off Seal Rocks 3 Jun; 1 same place 26 Aug (JP). Illawarra: 2 off Wollongong 1 Jun, seen regularly thereafter ("common" during Aug), last reported 20 Sep (DF, CC; IBOC; IMcA *et al*).

Shy Albatross *Diomedea cauta*Illawarra: 2 off Wollongong 10 Aug, subsp salvini (AMcB); max 10 through Aug, last seen off Bass Point 3 Nov (CC, IMcA *et al*). South Coast: max 75 off Green Cape 25–26 May (TR). 2 seen 3.5 naut. mls E of Montague Island 15 Aug, 1 *salvini* (NGC).

Southern Giant Petrel *Macronectes giganteus* Sydney region: 1 white morph at Cape Solander 30 Sep (JJF, JA, FJ).

Northern Giant Petrel *Macronectes halli* Sydney region: recorded Sydney Autumn Count 26 May (NSWFOC –80). Illawarra: 1 off Red Point, Wollongong 30 Jun; 1 seen 20 km off Wollongong 25 Nov (CC, AMcB). South Coast: 2 off Green Cape 25–26 May (TR).

Antarctic Fulmar Fulmarus glacialoides now AM O.58474 (LT et al per IMcA).

Mid-north Coast: 1 derelict at Dunbogan Beach 28 Oct,

Great-winged Petrel Pterodroma macroptera Northern Rivers: total 184 passing Ballina lighthouse during strong S wind 21 May (GH). Hunter: 3 off Munmorah SRA 30 Sep (EF). Sydney region: 2 seen ca 5 km off Sydney Heads 30 Jun, frequently reported Oct–Dec (DL, IMcA et al; AMcB).

White-headed Petrel *Pterodroma lessonii* Sydney region: 1 seen 40 km off Sydney Heads 22 Sep (AMcB). 2 seen 13 naut. mls SSE of Botany Bay 7 Nov (NGC). 1 derelict at Narrabeen Beach 8 Nov (IMcA).

Providence Petrel *Pterodroma solandri*Northern Rivers: 1 seen 11 naut. mls E of Cape Byron 26 Jul and 15 seen 17 naut. mls SE of Ballina same day, max 10-minute counts (NGC). 2 derelicts at Wardell 1 Nov (GH). Hunter: 3 seen 25 naut. mls E of Norah Head 27 Jul, max 10-minute count (NGC). Sydney region: recorded off Sydney Heads Apr–Jun and Sep–Dec, max 30 + on 22 Sep and 5 Oct, latest 1 on 15 Dec — has now been recorded all months off Sydney (IMcA *et al*, AMcB, NSWFOC –80, NGC). Illawarra: 60 + off Wollongong 10 Aug (AMcB). Gould's Petrel *Pterodroma leucoptera*Sydney region: 1 off Sydney Heads 28 Apr and 2 seen 30 Jun (IMcA *et al*); 3 seen 26 naut. mls SE of Botany Bay 7 Nov (NGC); 1 seen 30 km off Sydney Heads 15 Dec (AMcB). Tasman Sea: total 22 at sea up to 140 km off Port Stephens–Batemans Bay 22 Dec (AMcB).

Black-winged Petrel *Pterodroma nigripennis* Northern Rivers: heard (1+ seen) at night at Mutton Bird Island, Coffs Harbour 16 Jan (SGL). Tasman Sea: 2 at sea up to 140 km off Port Stephens–Batemans Bay 22 Dec (AMcB).

Cook's Petrel Pterodroma cookii Illawarra: 1 seen 45 km off Wollongong 25 Nov (AMcB et al). Tasman Sea: 1 seen ca 100 km off Sydney 22 Dec (CJC, GJR, TP, DH, AMcB).

White-necked Petrel *Pterodroma cervicalis* Sydney region: 1 off Sydney Heads 28 Jan; 1 seen 40 km off Sydney Heads 15 Dec (AMcB *et al*). Tasman Sea: 2 at sea up to 140 km off Port Stephens–Batemans Bay 22 Dec (AMcB). Details in prep.

Thin-billed Prion Pachyptila belcheri Illawarra: 2 seen 36 km off Wollongong 11 Aug (AMcB, IMcA et al).

Fairy Prion Pachyptila turtur Mid-north Coast: 3 off Port Stephens 3 Jun, probably this species (JP). Sydney region: recorded Sydney Autumn Count 26 May (NSWFOC –80). Illawarra: 50+ off

Bass Point, Wollongong 28 Jul; very common off Wollongong 11 Aug (CC; IMcA et al). South Coast: max ca 35 off Green Cape 25–26 May (TR).

Black Petrel *Procellaria parkinsoni* 2 off Sydney Heads 27 Oct (MJC *et al*); 1 seen 36 km off Sydney Heads 24 Nov (AMcB *et al*).

White-chinned Petrel *Procellaria aequinoctialis*Illawarra: 1 derelict, tentatively this species, at Port Kembla Beach 19 Dec, now AM O.58761 (DF, CC); examined at AM, shows several conflicting characters; identity still uncertain (IAWMcA, TRL).

Wedge-tailed Shearwater *Puffinus pacificus*Northern Rivers: 1 derelict at Wardell 11 Apr, pale morph (GH). Sydney region: 1 off Sydney Heads 26 May, unusually late (NSWFOC –80). Illawarra: 1 seen 20 km off Wollongong 11 Aug (AMcB *et al*). South Coast: 3 off Batemans Bay 19 Aug (AMcB).

Streaked Shearwater *Calonectris leucomela*Northern Rivers: 1 at Ballina 11 Apr, 1 same place 10 Sep (GH). Hunter: 1 male at Blacksmiths Beach, Newcastle 24 Jan, found distressed, later died, now AM O.57500 (BC). Sydney region: 2 off Sydney Heads 25 Feb and 1 on 28 Feb (IMcA, DL, AMcB et al). Illawarra: 1 at sea off Wollongong 23 Mar (AMcB); 1 derelict at South Beach, Wollongong 27 Dec, male, now AM O.58746 (DF per IMcA).

Buller's Shearwater *Puffinus bulleri*Northern Rivers: 1 at Evans Head 26 Feb; 1 derelict at Seven Mile Beach, Lennox Head 12 Apr (GH); 1 derelict just S of Sandon, Yuraygir NP 1 Nov, photographed (P&JS). Sydney region: 1 off Sydney Heads 28 Jan (AMcB *et al*). 1 seen *ca* 6 km off Sydney Heads 24 Mar (AEFR).

Sooty Shearwater *Puffinus griseus* Illawarra: recorded off Wollongong 11 Aug, very early date (IMcA *et al*). South Coast: 1 off Green Cape 25 May (TR).

Short-tailed Shearwater *Puffinus tenuirostris*30 Sep, average rate 110/min, almost constant stream from 1000–1700 hrs (EF). Sydney region: derelicts Oct–Nov, max 21 at Dee Why Beach 8 Nov (LJH per AM), no reports of major mortality. South Coast: 1 off Green Cape 25 May (TR).

Fluttering Shearwater *Puffinus gavia* Illawarra: much scarcer than usual offshore all year, counts seldom exceeding 20 (CC). South Coast: *ca* 100 off Green Cape 25–26 May (TR).

Hutton's Shearwater *Puffinus huttoni*Northern Rivers: 1 at Evans Head 25 Feb; 1 derelict at Wardell 11 Apr (GH). Sydney region: low numbers (max 5) off Sydney Heads Jan–Feb and Sep (AMcB, IMcA *et al*). Illawarra: 70 + birds off Wollongong 25 Nov (AMcB). South Coast: 2 off Green Cape 25–26 May (TR).

Little Shearwater *Puffinus assimilis* Sydney region: 1 off Sydney Heads 28 Apr, full notes supplied (IMcA, EF, DL). 1 derelict at Long Reef 9 Nov (WEB, IMcA).

Audubon's Shearwater *Puffinus Iherminieri* 1 seen 28 km off Sydney Heads 25 Feb; first NSW record, details in prep (AMcB *et al*).

Manx Shearwater *Puffinus puffinus* 1 photographed 32 km off Sydney Heads 22 Sep; first NSW record, details in prep (AMcB, TRL *et al*).

Wilson's Stormpetrel *Oceanites oceanicus*Sydney region: 1 off Sydney Heads 28 Apr, another 26 May (AMcB).

Darter Anhinga melanogaster Hunter: 40 + nests at Norahville STW Jan–Apr (SMI). Riverina: 25 + nests at Barrenbox Swamp near Griffith 11 Feb (SMI).

Great Cormorant *Phalacrocorax carbo*Hunter: 20–30 nests at Norahville STW Nov–Dec (SMI).
Illawarra: 1 at Barren Grounds NR 9 Dec (R&PJ). Riverina: 30 + nests at Barrenbox Swamp 11 Feb (SMI).

Pied Cormorant *Phalacrocorax varius*Hunter: ca 25 nests at Norahville STW Jan–Feb (SMI). Sydney region: 57 at Botany Bay 2 Feb, high local count (AKM).

Little Pied Cormorant *Phalacrocorax melanoleucos*Hunter: 75+ nests at Norahville STW Jan–Mar (SMI). Sydney region: 5+ at nests in date palms at Royal Botanic Gardens, Sydney 28 Aug (GPC).

Least Frigatebird Fregata ariel Northern Rivers: 2 at South Ballina 9 Jan (DAS). Hunter: 1 probable at Dudley Beach, Newcastle 11 Mar and 1 at Blacksmiths Beach 18 Mar (SJ, AW).

Red-tailed Tropicbird *Phaethon rubricauda*Northern Rivers: 1 derelict at Pottsville 14 Apr, immature (GH).

White-tailed Tropicbird *Phaethon lepturus*Northern Rivers: 1 adult at Valla Beach 25 Jan (CM per DS). 2 derelicts at South Ballina 17 Mar and another 28 Apr; 1 derelict at Seven Mile Beach, Lennox Head 12 Apr, all immature (GH). 1 at Coffs Harbour 21 Aug, seen frequently thereafter (AT). 1 derelict at Marley Beach, Royal NP 3 Nov, now AM unregistered (NSWFOC –80, DT & BL per AM). Illawarra: 1 derelict at Wollongong Beach 27 Dec (DF per IMcA). Tasman Sea: 2 at sea up to 140 km off Port Stephens–Batemans Bay 22 Dec (AMcB).

Pacific Heron *Ardea pacifica* South Coast: 2 small colonies at Moruya, 3 nests in one, 4 in the other (SM). Riverina: *ca* 250 nests at Barrenbox Swamp during Feb–Mar (JB, SMI).

White-faced Heron *Ardea novaehollandiae* Sydney region: 2 over edge of continental shelf off Sydney Heads 28 Feb; 1 seen 10 km off Sydney Heads 26 May, flying E (AMcB). 1 dead, being eaten by Swamp Harrier at Towra Point NR 30 Jun (AKM).

Cattle Egret *Ardeola ibis*Northern Rivers: 1000+ nests at Middle Boambee 18 Jan, mostly with nestlings; hundreds of nests at Lawrence 21 Jan (GPC). Hunter: recorded erratically along lower Hawkesbury near Dharug NP 29 Mar–18 Nov, max 36 at Roses Creek 21 Jul (GPC). Breeding at Shortland Swamp, Newcastle in Dec (MM). Riverina: 2 pairs nesting near Barham Jan–Feb, in mixed egret colony (PN&PMM).

Great Egret Egretta alba Hunter: breeding at Shortland Swamp, Newcastle in Dec (MM). Riverina: ca 100 pairs nesting at swamp 5 km SE of Mathoura during Jan–Feb and in Dec; ca 50 pairs nesting near Barham Jan–Feb, in mixed egret colony (PN&PMM).

Little Egret Egretta garzetta Hunter: 12–16 nests at Chittaway Point near Wyong Jan (SMI). Breeding at Shortland Swamp, Newcastle in Dec (MM). Sydney region: 2 at Towra Point NR 14 Apr, only 1984 record for locality (AKM). 1 at Pitt Town Ferry Road 11 Jul, 8 Aug and 29 Aug; 1 at Yarramundi Bridge 25 Jul, closely followed a Little Black Cormorant fishing in the river for some minutes (RB). Illawarra: 1 at Lake Illawarra 20 Jul (RB). Central-west Plain: 1 at Tottenham 21 Apr (NWS).

Plumed Egret *Egretta intermedia*Hunter: breeding at Shortland Swamp, Newcastle in Dec (MM). Sydney region: 2 in mangroves at Towra Point NR 26 Sep, 1 in partial breeding plumage (AKM). North-west Plain: 2 at Pilliga Lagoon 25 Apr (CC). Riverina: *ca* 200 pairs nesting near Barham Jan–Feb, in mixed egret colony; *ca* 80 pairs nesting at swamp 5 km SE of Mathoura during Jan–Feb and again in Dec (PN&PMM).

Mangrove Heron Butorides striatus Sydney region: 1 at Parramatta River, Meadowbank 13 Apr (incorrectly shown as 2 birds CBOC Newsletter Jul–Aug 84) (BD). 1 immature at Dee Why Lagoon 22 Jun (and several days thereafter) and 23 Jul (LJH). Illawarra: 1 at Mullet Creek, Lake Illawarra 6 Jan (KM). 2 at Duck Creek, Lake Illawarra 17 Mar (CC). South Coast: 1 at Orient Point, Shoalhaven River 10 Mar; 1 at Greenwell Point 1 Jul (CC).

Little Bittern Ixobrychus minutus Sydney region: 1 at Penrith Lakes 12 Jan (AC, KB per ESH). Southern Tableland: bred at Canberra, ACT (IT). Riverina: 2 at Lake Wyangan near Griffith 1 Jan (J&NR). Numerous at a swamp 5 km SE of Mathoura during Jan, mainly in Juncus ingens, and at a swamp near Gunbar Jan–Mar; numerous (breeding confirmed), in extensive cumbungi and lignum; ca 20 seen in a day, many more calling (PN&PMM). Lower Western: 1 at Dareton STW 16 Feb (JC).

Black Bittern *Dupetor flavicollis*Hunter: 1 at The Palms, Munmorah SRA 14 Apr (EF, IMcA). Sydney region: 1 at Mitchell Park 18 Feb (CC, PM per ESH); 1 at Stannix Park 24 Mar (RB). Illawarra: 2 at Duck Creek, Lake Illawarra 17 Mar (WE, CC). South Coast: 1 at Clyde River, Nerriga 24 May (JNH).

Brown Bittern *Botaurus poiciloptilus*Hunter: 1 probable heard at night at Mill Creek, Dharug NP 13 Dec and 17 Dec (GPC). Sydney region: 1 at Narrabeen Lake 17 Feb (JJF, JA, MS). 1 at Woolooware Swamp, Cronulla, seen several times 16 Sep–18 Oct (JJF). Riverina: 1 at Barrenbox Swamp 20 km NW of Griffith 1 Mar (JB).

Black-necked Stork *Xenorhynchus asiaticus*Northern Rivers: bird at nest at Swan Creek near Grafton 11 Sep (EW). Mid-north Coast: 2 at Bulahdelah 18 May (JP); 1 seen 2 km S of Taree 25 Aug (J&KI).

Glossy Ibis *Plegadis falcinellus*Hunter: recorded erratically Minmi–Raymond Terrace area Jan–Feb, Jun–Jul and Sep–Oct, max 19 at Hexham Swamp, Minmi 29 Jun (AW, RW, J&KI, SH, SJ, WPB). Sydney region: recorded erratically Hawkesbury Swamps Jun–Dec, max *ca* 10 at Bushells Lagoon 31 Dec (AKM, RB, AC, TQ, AEFR). Illawarra: 1 seen frequently at Dunmore 8 Aug–16 Dec, rare locally (IBOC). North-west Plain: 25 at Watercourse Swamp W of Moree 22 Apr, on the Collarenebri road (JHa). Riverina: *ca* 900 pairs nesting in cumbungi and lignum near Gunbar Jan–Mar; *ca* 2000 pairs nesting in lignum swamp 50 km NE of Balranald Nov–Dec; *ca* 4000 + pairs nesting in lignum near Booligal, most perished when swamps dried out (PN&PMM). Upper Western: 3 at Racecourse Swamp 2 km N Wilcannia 31 Aug; 16 at Oakvale Crossing, Paroo River 2 Sep (GLC). Lower Western: *ca* 55 at Lake Gol Gol near Dareton 15 Dec (JC). 8 at Stephens Creek Reservoir 16 Dec and 1 at Umberumberka Reservoir near Broken Hill 23 Dec; observer's first local records (NWSh). Recorded at Coombie HSD near Roto in Dec (JH).

Sacred Ibis *Threskiornis aethiopica*Northern Rivers: 1 pair nesting in egret colony at Lawrence in Dec (SGL). Hunter: 71 at Roses Creek near Dharug NP 31 Jul, high local count (GPC). Sydney region: 6+ nests at Taronga Zoo 30 Aug; 8+ nests in date palms at Royal Botanic Gardens 28 Aug (GPC). Central-west Plain: 300–400 pairs with eggs or small young, northern section Macquarie Marshes NR in Jan (RA per AKM). Riverina: 5000+ nests at Barrenbox Swamp 11 Feb, in cumbungi, mostly eggs, few young chicks (SMI).

Straw-necked Ibis *Threskiornis spinicollis*Riverina: *ca* 20 000 pairs nesting at Littlewood HSD 50 km NE of Balranald Nov–Dec; *ca* 30 000 pairs nesting at Booligal HSD in Dec, first breeding at the site since 1969 (JB); *ca* 80 000 pairs nesting in lignum near Booligal, massive casualties when swamps dried out (PN&PMM).

Royal Spoonbill *Platalea regia*Northern Rivers: 50 pairs nested at Harwood Island, Clarence River during Dec (EW per AKM). Riverina: 8+ nests at Barrenbox Swamp 11 Feb, in upper branches of willows (SMI).

Yellow-billed Spoonbill *Platalea flavipes*Northern Rivers: 1 pair at nest at Clarenza during Dec, unusual coastal breeding record (EW per AKM). Hunter: 1 at Roses Creek near Dharug NP 10–29 Jul (GPC).

Magpie Goose Anseranas semipalmata Northern Rivers: 21 at Caramana Pond, Waterview near Grafton 6 Sep; 19 same place 3 Nov (GPC). Hunter: 3–4 at Seaham Swamp NR 14 Jul, 9 Dec and 23 Dec (MM, GA, WPB, J&NR). Central-west Plain: 7 at Macquarie Marshes 25 Jan and 4 on 29 Dec (TKo per AKM, AL). Riverina: 3 at Lytton HSD near Barham 28 Feb (EBT). 2 at Warrawidgee 15 km W of Griffith 3–4 Mar (JB). For detailed review of recent records in NSW see Clancy 1985. Aust. Birds 19:41–45.

Wandering Whistling-duck *Dendrocygna arcuata*Northern Rivers: 2 at Tweed Heads 21 Oct (GH). 8 near Woolgoolga 9 Oct, 1 same place 27 Oct (SGL). Mid-north Coast: 3–4 at Port Macquarie STW 29–30 Oct and 20 Dec (AR, GPC). Hunter: max 9 at Shortland Swamp, Newcastle 10 Mar, 23 May, 17 Oct (MM, GA, BC).

Plumed Whistling-duck *Dendrocygna eytoni*Northern Rivers: recorded at Clarenza Jan to mid-Sep, max 60 on 9–30 Mar and 10 Sep, and 300 on 28 Sep; small flock at Waterview 6 Sep (EW, GPC). Hunter: 6 at Morpeth STW 8 Jan (JS, WPB). Sydney region: max count 327 at Hawkesbury Agricultural College, Richmond 29 Jul (DJ). North-west Slope: 100+ at Mooki River near Quirindi 19 May (RB). Central-west Slope: 27 near Bullenbung, Wagga-Lockhart 23 Sep (RB). Central-west Plain: 18 at Tottenham 21 Apr (NWS).

Black Swan *Cygnus atratus*Northern Rivers: recorded regularly at Nambucca Heads during Mar, most flying N (DS). Upper Western: 17 at Purnawilla Lake 30 km NNE of Wilcannia 27 Aug–7 Sep, 1 nest, 3 pairs with young; 2 nests at Racecourse Lagoon, 1 pair with well-grown young 27 Aug–7 Sep (GLC).

Freckled Duck Stictonetta naevosa Riverina: numerous at swamp near Gunbar Jan–Mar; numerous, 2 nests found at swamp near Booligal 24 Dec, all males in breeding condition (PN&PMM).

Australian Shelduck *Tadorna tadornoides* Sydney region: 3 at Pitt Town Lagoon 22 Dec (ARMcG, J&NR), 1 same place 31 Dec (AC, TQ, AEFR). Flock 32 seen 27 naut. mls SE of Sydney Heads 12 Nov, flew around ship and departed SE (NGC). Illawarra: 11 at Shoalhaven Heads 1 Jul (B&CV, CC). South Coast: 1 at Nowra 10 Jun, 11 at Comerong Island 1 Jul, locally rare (IBOC per WE). Upper Western: 1 at Racecourse Swamp 2 km N of Wilcannia 27 Aug–7 Sep; 3 at Lake Purnawilla 30 km NNE of Wilcannia 30 Aug–7 Sep (GLC).

Black Duck Anas superciliosa River Jun-Jul (GPC). Hunter: substantial numbers (max 300+) on Lower Macdonald

Mallard Anas platyrhynchos Northern Rivers: 1 male at Susan Island, Grafton 2 Nov, with hybrid female (GPC). Mid-north Coast: 1 female at Port Macquarie STW 5 Jul, 9 Sep, 29 Oct and 20 Dec (GPC). Hunter: 2 at Teralba 3 Jun (WPB, MG).

Chestnut Teal Anas castanea Sydney region: 496 at Parramatta River 15 Apr, max local count (H&BM, JD, AKM). Riverina: 6 males at Lake Wyangan near Griffith 24 Jun; 1 nest plus 3 young same place 12 Dec (JB).

Blue-winged Shoveler Anas rhynchotis

Sydney region: recorded Hawkesbury swamps Feb-Aug, max 40 + at Pitt Town Lagoon 15 Aug (RB, J&NR). 8 flying SE 10 km off Sydney Heads 23 Jun (AMcB). 2 at Stinkpot Bay, Towra Point NR 30 Jun, first local record (AKM). Illawarra: ca 50–60 at Lake Illawarra during Jun-Jul, minor influx; 6 at Bong Bong Reservoir 2 Sep (CC). South Coast: 5 at Comerong Island 4 Aug; 6 same place 1 Sep (CC). Riverina: 200 + at Griffith STW 1 Jan (J&NR).

Pink-eared Duck *Malacorhynchus membranaceus*region: recorded Pitt Town Lagoon 11 Aug–31 Dec, max 25 on 11 Aug (J&NR, RB, AC, TQ, AEFR). Illawarra: 1 at Tallawarra ash ponds 3 Jun and 7 same place 8 Jul (CC, IBOC). Riverina: 1000 + at Griffith STW 1 Jan (J&NR). Upper Western: recorded at Mt Murchison HSD 27 Aug–7 Sep, est 10 000 (GLC).

Hardhead Aythya australis Mid-north Coast: 150+ at Port Macquarie STW 5 Jul; 100+ same place 20 Dec (GPC). Sydney region: 120 at Pitt Town Lagoon 23 Jun (AKM). Illawarra: 35 at Tallawarra ash ponds 3 Jun (CC). 84 at Hoskins NR, Moss Vale 4 Aug (KM). 30 at Bong Bong Reservoir 2 Sep (CC). Lower Western: 40+ at Umberumberka Reservoir ca 20 km W of Broken Hill 23 Dec (NWSh).

Maned Duck Chenonetta jubata Hunter: 200+ near Gunderman 23 May, high local count (GPC).

Blue-billed Duck Oxyura australis Southern Tableland: bred at Lake Bathurst (IT). Riverina: 50 at Griffith STW 1 Jan (J&NR); many pairs with young at extensive lignum swamp near Booligal 24 Dec (PN&PMM). Upper Western: 1 male at Oakvale Crossing, Paroo River 1 Sep; max 8 at Racecourse Swamp 2 km N of Wilcannia 2–6 Sep (GLC). Nest at Fords Bridge 12 Sep (GH).

Osprey Pandion haliaetus Northern Rivers: 4 known pairs nesting in Nambucca Valley, one failed, outcome otherwise unknown (DS, GPC). Mid-north Coast: nests known near Taree, Port Macquarie and Forster, total 1 young fledged (GPC, RM per AKM). Hunter: nesting near Newcastle (GPC); 1 at East Gosford 17 Oct; 1 at Terrigal Lagoon 18 Oct (DCR). 1–3 seen at least 6 occasions at Lake Macquarie Jan–Sep, young being fed (SH, AW). South Coast: 1 at Murrays Beach, Jervis Bay NR 22 Jun (CC).

Black-shouldered Kite *Elanus notatus*North-west Plain: 6 pairs nesting on 1 km of creek at Goorianawa in Apr, near nesting Black Kites and Spotted Harriers (DJ per AKM).

Black Kite *Milvus migrans* Mid-north Coast: 1 at Woko NP 30 Jan (SH). Hunter: 1 at Redhead rubbish tip 14 Mar (AW). 1 seen 10 km SE of Denman 26 Nov (IMcA). North-west Plain: 1 pair nesting on 1 km of creek at Goorianawa in Apr, near nesting Spotted Harriers and Black-shouldered Kites (DJ per AKM).

Square-tailed Kite *Lophoictinia isura*South-west Slope: 2 at Lake Cowal 24 Jun, unusual winter record (NWS). North-west Plain: 1 at Warrumbungles NP 13 Nov (ARMcG). Upper Western: 1 at Four Corners Lake 42 km NE of Wilcannia 30 Aug; 1 possible at Jamieson Billabong 52 km NE Wilcannia 1 Sep (GLC). Lower Western: 1 at Lake Gol Gol, Buronga 13 Nov (JNH).

Lower Western: 1 at Fletchers Lake, Dareton 23 Jan (JNH).

Peregrine Falcon Falco peregrinus Mid-north Coast: 1 at Smiths Lake 1 May (GPC). Hunter: seen frequently in lower Hawkesbury area May–Dec, 1 near suspected nest at Dharug NP 26 Feb (GPC). Bar-tailed Godwit *Limosa lapponica* Most counts somewhat higher than normal: 1720 at Kooragang Island NR 3 Feb (J&KI per AKM); 860 at Botany Bay 26 Oct (AKM, JPg, MDb); 206 at Parramatta River 29 Dec (H&BM, JD per AKM); 196 at Windang 6 Nov (CC); 748 at Comerong Island 27 Oct (CC).

Hudsonian Godwit *Limosa haemastica*Nov (DJa, H&BM, AIGH).

Curlew Sandpiper *Calidris ferruginea*Highest counts: 1366 at Kooragang Island NR 3 Feb (AKM); 510 at Parramatta River 20 Jan; (H&BM, JD, AKM); 610 at Botany Bay 22 Sep (JPg, MDb, AKM). Upper Western: 60 + at Oakvale, Paroo River 30 Aug-1 Sep; recorded at Racecourse Swamp 2 km N of Wilcannia 5 Sep (GLC).

Sanderling Calidris alba Northern Rivers: 42 at South Ballina Beach 5 Feb, 63 same place 10 Dec, largest local count on record (JM per AKM; GH). 1 at Nambucca Heads 28 Dec (DS). Sydney region: 2 at Boat Harbour 22 Mar (AKM). Illawarra: 38 at Windang 8 Feb, 12 same place 16 Feb, 16 on 21 Mar, 7 on 1 Apr; 1 at Shellharbour Beach 4 Oct; 1 at Windang 9 Nov (CC).

Broad-billed Sandpiper *Limicola falcinellus*Northern Rivers: 1 seen frequently at Ballina 22

Southern Skua Catharacta antarctica Few reports. Sydney region: 1 off Sydney Heads 26 May (AMcB). 2 off Cape Solander 7 Jul (J&NR). 7 seen 8 naut. mls ESE of Botany Bay 29 Jul, 1 followed ship until 19 naut. mls E of Ulladulla (NGC).

Arctic Jaeger Stercorarius parasiticus Few reports, low numbers. Departure off Sydney Heads 26 May, arrival Nambucca Heads and Botany Bay 23 Oct (DS, NSWFOC –80, AMcB, AKM).

Pomarine Jaeger Stercorarius pomarinus Northern Rivers: 2 at Nambucca Heads 9 May (DS). Hunter: 2 off Newcastle 1 Apr (TKn). Sydney region: 4 off Sydney Heads 28 Apr (AMcB).

Kelp Gull Larus dominicanus

Whiskered Tern Chlidonias hybrida Northern Rivers: nesting (ca 50 young) at Casino 10 Mar (GH). Riverina: ca 500+ pairs nesting in 2 canegrass swamps near Gunbar Jan–Mar (PN&PMM). 1000+ at Mirrool Creek NW of Griffith 12 Feb, 10+ nests (SMI). 500+ at Mirrool Creek 6 Oct, most in breeding plumage (RB). Flock 2000+ at Mirrool Creek, Gunbar 26 Oct (JDx, ARMcG). Upper Western: recorded at Mt Murchison HSD 27 Aug–7 Sep, small numbers most wetlands (GLC). Lower Western: 20+ at Stephens Creek Reservoir 10 km E of Broken Hill 16 Dec (NWSh).

Flock 22 at Ourimbah 10 Oct (AKM). Sydney region: 13 flying S over Taren Point bridge ca 0830 hrs 14 Oct (AR). Illawarra: 70+ at Jamberoo Pass 4 Aug (AC, ARMcG et al). Crested Pigeon Ocyphaps lophotes Mid-north Coast: 1 found dead at Bulahdelah 5 May (ABR per AM). Recorded often at South Turramurra Jun–Aug (IMcA). 2 at Beacon Hill 31 Aug (LJH). 3 at Yowie Bay 4 Nov, feeding in banksia (JJF). Central Tableland: 27 at Wentworth Falls 19 Feb, feeding in Pinus radiata (RJT). 2 at Munghorn Gap NR 29 Oct (AIGH).

Gang-gang Cockatoo Callocephalon fimbriatum Hunter: recorded frequently Dharug NP (nested Oct–Dec) and Watagan Mts (GPC, PN HBOC, JAx HBOC, GH). Sydney region: 2 at Peakhurst 9 Feb (J&NR). 9 at Pitt Town Lagoon 17 Mar (IMcA); two groups resident Lane Cove River area, Epping and South Turramurra (DL, IMcA). Central Tableland: 2 seen 15 km S of Merriwa 13–17 Jun (MEMcA per IMcA). South-west Slope: 2 at Illalong Creek 7 km S of Binalong 27 Oct (BH).

Galah Cacatua roseicapilla Illawarra: 1 seen 14 nm SE of Port Kembla 18 Aug (NGC). Lower Western: ca 4000 at roost in flooded red gums at Talpee HSD near Balranald 24 Apr (JB).

Long-billed Corella Cacatua tenuirostris

Hunter: 2 at Shortland Swamp, Newcastle 16 Mar, 19 Aug and 16 Oct (JP, WPB). Sydney region: reported at Royal NP, Sydney Harbour NP, Dee Why Lagoon, Wahroongah, Turramurra, max metropolitan count 52 (AMR, AMt, LJH, AKM, EF, IMcA). Sulphur-crested Cockatoo Cacatua galerita Hunter: large flocks at Lower Macdonald Mar–Jun, max 450 + on 9 Jun (GPC). Illawarra: recorded Dapto–Balgownie during May and Nov (IBOC).

Rainbow Lorikeet *Trichoglossus haematodus*Illawarra: minor influx Nowra–Berry area Jul–Aug; mainly in flowering Spotted Gums (CC). South-west Slope: 2 at Lake Cargelligo town 26 Nov, in *Tamarix aphylla*, ?escapees (JB).

Grey Fantail *Rhipidura fuliginosa* Upper Western: uncommon at Mt Murchison HSD 27 Aug-7 Sep (GLC). Lower Western: arrival 2 at No. 183 Dam, Lake Nearie near Wentworth 7 Apr (SBOC per JB); arrival Dareton 20 Apr, departure 2 Oct (JNH).

Logrunner Orthonyx temminckii Illawarra: 1 below Mount Keira 4 Aug (J&NR). 2 adults and 2 young in relict rainforest at Barrengarry Mountain, near Kangaroo Valley 7 Oct (DF, CC). ca 3 (1 immature) at Woonona Heights, Wollongong Oct–Nov (KM).

Chirruping Wedgebill *Psophodes cristatus* 27 Aug–7 Sep (GLC).

Upper Western: uncommon at Mt Murchison HSD

Chestnut Quailthrush Cinclosoma castanotum JB).

Lower Western: 4 at Euston 9 Jun (SBOC per

Chestnut-breasted Quailthrush *Cinclosoma castaneothorax* Upper Western: recorded at Gunderbooka Range, Cobar–Bourke Road 13 Sep (GH).

White-browed Babbler *Pomatostomus superciliosus*SE of Bundarra during Jul and Sep–Oct (AL). Upper Western: uncommon at Mt Murchison HSD 27 Aug–7 Sep, in leopardwood woodland only (GLC).

Chestnut-crowned Babbler *Pomatostomus ruficeps*Central-west Plain: flock 5 in saltbush at Micabil 18 km W of Condobolin 19 Jul (JB). Upper Western: common at Mt Murchison HSD 27 Aug–7 Sep, nesting (GLC).

Clamorous Reed-warbler *Acrocephalus stentoreus*5 Jul (GPC). Hunter: 1 at Shortland Swamp, Newcastle 22 Jul (WPB). Sydney region: recorded at Yarramundi Lagoon 26 May (RB). Upper Western: 1 at Oakvale, Paroo River 30 Aug; 2 calling at Mt Murchison HSD 5 Sep (GLC); 1 in low scrub near the Darling River at Bourke 24 Aug (GBw). Lower Western: 5 + at Lake Nearie near Wentworth 7 Apr, including adults feeding young, unusual date (SBOC per JC). 1 at Imperial Lake, Broken Hill 23 Sep, observer's first local record (NWSh).

Tawny Grassbird *Megalurus timoriensis*Hunter: nesting at Shortland Swamp, Newcastle during Feb, also recorded 14 Apr (GA; IMcA, EF); several at Seaham Swamp 3 Sep (BG). Sydney region: 2–4 territories at Beacon Hill 31 Aug and 1 Nov (LJH).

Golden-headed Cisticola *Cisticola exilis* Illawarra: 1 at Barren Grounds NR 15 Apr, second local record (J&PJ). North-west Plain: recorded in thick grass around old irrigation dam on Collarenebri road W of Moree 22 Apr (JHa). Lower Western: now established in all swampy areas in far SW, west to Pomona N of Wentworth where occupying irrigated sorghum (JNH).

Rufous Songlark Cinclorhamphus mathewsi
Sydney region: recorded at Grose Wold 18 Jan, observer's only Sydney region record during 1984 (LS). Illawarra: 4 at Bullio W of Mittagong 31 Dec; 4 at Goodmans Ford W of Mittagong 31 Dec (CC). South-west Slope: 1 at Ingalba NR 25 Aug, an early date (J&NR). Riverina: arrival Griffith 2 Sep (JB). Upper Western: common at Mt Murchison HSD 27 Aug–7 Sep (GLC). Lower Western: 3 at Buronga STW 21 Jul, unusual winter record (JC); arrival Banoon HSD 40 km NE of Mildura 31 Aug (JB).

Brown Songlark *Cinclorhamphus cruralis*Upper Western: recorded at Mt Murchison HSD 27 Aug–7 Sep, uncommon then abundant by 6 Sep, obviously just arriving (GLC).

Red-backed Fairywren Malurus melanocephalus (HBOC).

Mid-north Coast: 7 at Woko NP 28-30 Jan

Southern Emuwren Stipiturus malachurus Northern Rivers: recorded at Wilsons Peak, Koreelah SF near Woodenbong 22 Apr (GH). Hunter: 2 at Roses Creek, Dharug NP 11 Feb; 2 at Dinner Creek near Spencer 13 Aug (GPC). 4+ pairs on island below The Entrance bridge near Gosford 14 Oct (DCR). Illawarra: 2 below Mount Keira 28 Apr (J&NR). Northern Tableland: recorded at Tooloom Scrub 5 Oct and 18 Nov (GH). Central Tableland: 3 at Kings Tableland, Wentworth Falls 23 Mar; 1 near Blackheath 4 Aug (RJT).

Grey Grasswren *Amytornis barbatus*Upper Western: 1 male found dead at Caryapundy Swamp *ca* 50 km NE of Tibooburra 28 Aug, now AM O.58004 (JWH *et al* per AM).

Eastern Bristlebird Dasyornis brachypterus Northern Rivers: 11 new territories between Levers Plateau and Nightcap Range, Tweed Range Oct–Nov; now 30 known territories in the region (GH).

Rock Warbler *Origma solitaria*South Coast: 1 at Bundanoon, Morton NP 17 Oct (DJP). Central Tableland: 9 at Wollangambe River 13 Oct, 1 active, 2 old, nests (RJT). Nesting 15 km S of Merriwa 25 Nov, 1 km from nearest surface water (IMcA).

Yellow-throated Scrubwren Sericornis citreogularis
NP 1–2 Jul, ?first park record (GPC).
Hunter: 1–2 at Simpsons Track, Dharug

White-browed Scrubwren Sericornis frontalis 2 seen 15 km S of Merriwa 25 Nov, in small grove of Backhousia myrtifolia (40.5 ha), observer's first local record (IMcA).

Shy Heathwren *Hylacola cauta* Lower Western: several pairs resident at Coombie HSD near Roto (JH).

Redthroat *Pyrrholaemus brunneus* Lower Western: 2 seen 20 km N of Penarie 20 Apr and 1 near Penarie 28 Apr (AMcB); 4 near Wentworth 29 Aug (J&NR); seen regularly at Hatfield; max 8 at Moorna HSD W of Wentworth all year (JNH, ARMcG).

Mangrove Warbler *Gerygone levigaster* Sydney region: recorded Brisbane Water 3 Nov (NSWFOC –85); 1 at Towra Point NR 14 Nov (AKM).

Western Warbler *Gerygone fusca*Upper Western: uncommon at Mt Murchison HSD 27 Aug–7 Sep (GLC). Lower Western: pair at nest at Woorlong HSD, Gol Gol in Dec; nest and eggs in low mallee, broken eggshell, no young; first far SW breeding; western breeding limit Balranald (RC, JNH).

White-throated Warbler *Gerygone olivacea*Northern Rivers: arrival Hungry Head and Valla 28 Aug, Nambucca Heads 1 Sep (DS). Mid-north Coast: recorded Port Macquarie 3 Sep (GPC). Hunter: departure Dharug NP 17 Mar (GPC). Sydney region: recorded at Stannix Park 4 Apr and at Kings Plains 7 Oct (RB). South Coast: arrival Moruya 11 Oct (SM).

Brown Thornbill *Acanthiza pusilla* Northern Tableland: 1 found dead at Glencoe near Glen Innes 23 Jul, now AM 0.58289; near western limit (SGL per AM).

Inland Thornbill *Acanthiza apicalis* Upper Western: recorded at Mt Murchison HSD 27 Aug–7 Sep, rare, only in leopardwood woodland (GLC).

White-browed Treecreeper Climacteris affinis Riverina: several at Stackpoole SF 25 km NE of Goolgowi 5 May, observer's first record S of the Lachlan; most potential habitat in the area now cleared (PN&PMM). Upper Western: uncommon at Mt Murchison HSD 27 Aug-7 Sep, in

leopardwood woodland (GLC); recorded at Gunderbooka Range, Cobar–Bourke Road 13 Sep (GH). Lower Western: 3 seen 35 km NE of Mildura 20 Apr (AD, AMcB); 1 at Euston 9 Jun (SBOC per JC); recorded at Coombie HSD near Roto in Jul (JH); 8 near Dareton 29 Aug (J&NR); 4 near Hollands Lake E of Dareton 10 Sep (CC).

Spiny-cheeked Honeyeater *Acanthagenys rufogularis* Sydney region: 1 in banksia heath at South Head, Sydney Harbour NP 4 Dec, 3rd Sydney record (AKM).

Striped Honeyeater *Plectorhyncha lanceolata* Mid-north Coast: 2 at Canton Beach, Toukley 19 Jun (FR). Central Tableland: 1 near Glen Davis 10 Nov (RJT).

Regent Honeyeater *Xanthomyza phrygia*Status controversial — all reports listed. Sydney region: 1 at Peakhurst 27 May (J&NR); recorded Sydney Autumn Count 26 May (NSWFOC –80). Northern Tableland: several pairs nesting 25 km SE of Bundarra Aug–Oct; 1 at Two Mile Creek 24 km SE of Bundarra 22 Dec (AL). Central Tableland: 14 at Munghorn Gap NR 22 Apr, in yellow box and white box woodland (AKM) and 8 same place 10 Jun (HBOC). 6 near Glen Davis 2 Jun (AC *et al* per ESH). 2 seen 15 km S of Merriwa 2 Sep, observer's first local record; 4 same place 22–29 Nov, adults feeding 2 chicks (MEMCA, IMCA). South-west Slope: 1 at Illalong Creek 15 km S of Binalong 27 Oct (BH). North-west Plain: pair breeding near Upper Bingara 2 Jan (JHa).

Blue-faced Honeyeater *Entomyzon cyanotis* Hunter: 2 adults, 2 juvs at Wrights Creek near St Albans 20 Jan (IAC per GPC). 2 at Gibba Swamp, Putty Road 18 Nov (P&JS).

Bell Miner *Manorina melanophrys* Illawarra: 6 at Goodmans Ford 50 km W of Mittagong 31 Dec, new County of Camden locality (CS, CC).

Singing Honeyeater *Lichenostomus virescens*Bogan Gate 20 May (NWS). Central-west Plain: 1 at Tottenham 21 Apr (NWS).

Mangrove Honeyeater *Lichenostomus fasciogularis* and at Terranora Broadwater 21 Oct (GH).

Northern Rivers: recorded at Iluka 11 Mar

White-eared Honeyeater *Lichenostomus leucotis* 20 Aug (SM).

South Coast: arrival Moruya 10 Apr, departure

Grey-fronted Honeyeater *Lichenostomus plumulus* HSD near Roto in Apr (JH).

Lower Western: first recorded at Coombie

Fuscous Honeyeater *Lichenostomus fuscus*South Coast: arrival Moruya 1 May, departure 6 Oct (SM). Central Tableland: recorded 15 km S of Merriwa 3 Mar — very rare locally (IMcA). Centralwest Slope: 60 at Back Yamma SF near Forbes 20 May, gradually increasing to 200 + on 28 Sep; abundant flowering white box; continual nesting (NWS).

Black-chinned Honeyeater *Melithreptus gularis*Central Tableland: 4 at Munghorn Gap NR 22 Apr, including 1 retrap banded same place 7 years before (AKM). Central-west Plain: 2 at Tottenham 22 Apr (NWS). Riverina: numerous along Murray River between Corowa and Tocumwal during Sep, in flowering yellow box (PN&PMM).

Brown-headed Honeyeater *Melithreptus brevirostris* III NR 17 Mar, first recent local record (J&PJ).

Illawarra: recorded at Barren Grounds

Painted Honeyeater *Grantiella picta* Central Tableland: 7 at Goulburn River NP 16 Sep (SH et al). none recorded 15 km S of Merriwa during 1984 — late flowering and fruiting of mistletoe; see

1983 Report (IMcA). South-west Slope: 3+ at Clear Ridge near Wyalong 27 Oct (JDx, ARMcG). Upper Western: 1 at Gunderbooka Range, Cobar–Bourke Road 13 Sep (GH).

Crescent Honeyeater Phylidonyris pyrrhoptera Hunter: 6+ at Munmorah SRA 21 Apr (EF).

New Holland Honeyeater *Phylidonyris novaehollandiae* Northern Rivers: recorded at Donaldson SF 20 Apr and at Wilsons Peak, Koreelah SF 24 Apr (GH).

White-cheeked Honeyeater *Phylidonyris nigra*Central Tableland: 1 at Linden Ridge 27 May; recorded at Martins Lookout near Springwood 17 Jun (RJT).

White-fronted Honeyeater *Phylidonyris albifrons* Lower Western: recorded at Matakana 14 Sep (GH); nested at Coombie HSD near Roto in Jul–Sep (JH 04/130).

Eastern Spinebill Acanthorhynchus tenuirostris (PN&PMM). Riverina: 1 in garden at Deniliquin Jun–Sep

Black Honeyeater *Certhionyx niger*Riverina: 1 at Scenic Hill, Griffith 1 Oct (JB). 2 near Goolgowi 26 Oct, male in full song (JDx, ARMcG). Upper Western: recorded at Mount Merrere N of Cobar 13 Sep (GH). Lower Western: influx Dareton area, began 11 Aug (JNH J&NR); arrival Coombie HSD near Roto in Sep (JH). 2+ at Garston HSD near Wentworth 6 Oct, 4 at Euston 20 Oct (JC). Last recorded Dareton 24 Nov; 18 nests found locally in 3 sites, two in *Eremophila maculata*, one in *Casuarina cristata*, all in prolific bloom (JNH).

Pied Honeyeater *Certhionyx variegatus*Lower Western: max 4 at Dareton 22 Sep–9 Oct, male in persistent display flight but no breeding recorded (JNH).

Scarlet Honeyeater *Myzomela sanguinolenta*Perhaps more common than usual Hunter, Sydney and Illawarra regions; many reports but data difficult to evaluate. Central Tableland: recorded 15 km S of Merriwa 3 Mar, 21 Apr, 2–3 Sep and (very common) 23–26 Nov, first local records since Feb 1978 (IMcA). 1 at Lapstone 2 Sep, feeding in *Eucalyptus beyenii*; also recorded near Glen Davis 10 Nov (RJT). Recorded at Boggy Swamp Creek, Putty road 26 Nov (IMcA).

Crimson Chat *Ephthianura tricolor* Upper Western: recorded at Hungerford and at Yantabulla 12 Sep (GH). Lower Western: arrival *ca* 30 at Hazeldell HSD near Wentworth 6 Oct, but very few birds in contrast to 1983 (JNH, SBOC per JC); small party at Lake Mungo 14 Dec (IMcA, WEB). None at Coombie HSD near Roto in 1984 (JH).

Red-browed Pardalote Pardalotus rubricatus

Upper Western: recorded at Mt Murchison HSD

29 Aug–4 Sep, pair excavating nest-hole (GLC). 1 seen 64 km S of Camerons Corner 12 Oct, on
SA border (PN&PMM).

Striated Pardalote *Pardalotus striatus* Subspecies *striatus*: 2 at Back Yamma SF near Forbes 12 Jul (NWS).

European Goldfinch Carduelis carduelis Sydney region: 2 at South Head, Sydney Harbour NP 20 Dec, first local record in years (AKM). Lower Western: 1 at Coombie HSD near Roto 16 Oct (JH).

Greenfinch Carduelis chloris Sydney region: 5 adults at Port Botany 28 Jul (JW).

Beautiful Firetail Emblema bella South Coast: 1 at Tomerong Road SW of Nowra 2 Nov (KM).

Zebra Finch *Poephila guttata* Illawarra: 200 + at Bass Point SRA 7 Jul (DF, CC, IBOC per WE). Lower Western: 3 nests at Yalcowinnia Creek on the Wilcannia Road 50 km NE of Broken Hill 7 Sep, all built into base of Spotted Harrier nest (JB).

Chestnut-breasted Mannikin Lonchura castaneothorax Hunter: 3 at Roses Creek, Dharug NP 11 Feb and 26 Feb (GPC). Illawarra: 200–300 at Bass Point SRA 7–15 Jul, decreasing to 40 on 8 Aug and 6 on 17 Aug (DF, CC, IBOC per WE).

Common Starling *Sturnus vulgaris* Lord Howe Island: recorded 5–16 May, max count 8; 1 on 5 May but none seen on census 12 May (BJK).

Common Myna Acridotheres tristis

Hunter: recorded intermittently all year at Dharug NP and Macdonald River valley; max count 45 + at Wisemans Ferry 24 Mar (GPC). 2 at Charlestown 17 Jun (AW). Illawarra: recorded at Mittagong 17 May (GPC). South Coast: 2 at Erowal Bay 11 Jan (CS). Southern Tableland: recorded at Marulan 6 May (GPC).

Olive-backed Oriole *Oriolus sagittatus*South Coast: departure Moruya 10 Mar, arrival 28 Aug (SM). Central-west Plain: recorded at Inglewarra HSD near Gulargambone 30 Jul (DB). 1 at Dareton 15 Aug, very rare far SW (JNH).

Figbird Sphecotheres viridis

Sydney region: 2 at Bernera HSD, Hoxton Park 11 Nov, in isolated Moreton Bay Figs Ficus macrophylla just ripening, area dry cleared land (DL). Illawarra: 1 male at Gerroa S of Kiama 30 Jan (KM); 4–6 at Bass Point SRA 15–21 Jul (CC).

Spangled Drongo *Dicrurus hottentottus*Normal scatter of reports Northern Rivers and Midnorth Coast. Hunter: 1 at Mill Creek, Dharug NP 10 Feb, 12 Mar and 16 Mar (GPC); recorded at Spencer 14 Apr (EF, IMcA); 1 at Canton Beach, Toukley 19 Jun, feeding at flowering coral tree (FR). Sydney region: major influx, numerous reports spanning 11 Feb–14 Oct; regularly seen Royal NP, Kurnell, Towra Point NR, Sydney Harbour NP, Mosman, Turramurra and elsewhere, including Botanical Gardens, Hyde Park and Macquarie Street in the centre of the city; mostly near coast but also reported East Hills and Wilberforce. Seen almost daily some areas (*eg* Sydney Harbour NP 14 Feb–14 Oct, max 6), about 30 additional isolated reports; mostly single birds, but 8 (in two flocks) at Turramurra 30 Mar (J&NR, AKM, AIGH, WEB, IMcA, DL, RB *et al*, LS, RB, SFN, JBv, DJP, LJH, G&HB, BD, RMr, EF). Illawarra: 1–3 locally 14 Feb–22 Jun, total 23 records within County of Camden, unusually common over 9 months, usually only Feb–May (IBOC per WE).

Satin Bowerbird *Ptilonorhynchus violaceus* 13 Jul (AL).

Northern Tableland: 1 at UNE campus, Armidale

Spotted Bowerbird Chlamydera maculata Oct (JC).

Lower Western: 3 near active bower at Euston 20

Paradise Riflebird *Ptiloris paradiseus*Northern Rivers: 1 female at Star Creek, Coramba 22 Sep, at 100 m asl (DS). Mid-north Coast: recorded at Sharpes Creek camping ground, Gloucester Tops 22–23 Apr (IMcA).

Apostlebird Struthidea cinerea Sydney region: record—85).

Sydney region: recorded Sydney Spring Count 3 Nov (NSWFOC

Magpie-lark *Grallina cyanoleuca* Illawarra: 4 at Barren Grounds NR 17 Mar, second local record (J&PJ). Riverina: several large flocks (100+) at Griffith during Apr (JB). Lord Howe Island: very common 5–16 May, max count 57 on 12 May (BJK).

White-breasted Woodswallow *Artamus leucorhynchus*Northern Rivers: departure Nambucca
Heads 13 May, arrival 11 Aug; departure Valla 9 May, arrival 13 Aug (DS). Hunter: 52 at Dora Creek
6 Feb (RW).

Masked Woodswallow *Artamus personatus*Upper Western: small numbers at Mt Murchison HSD 31 Aug–7 Sep (GLC). Lower Western: substantial numbers associated with a major influx of White-browed Woodswallows (*qv*) in Apr and again from Aug onwards; breeding at Lake Garnpung and Lake Mungo 14–20 Dec (WEB, IMcA, JNH).

White-browed Woodswallow Artamus superciliosus Mid-north Coast: 2 seen N of Tea Gardens 17 Dec (A&GB). South-west Slope: recorded at Ingalba NR 25 Aug (J&NR). Central-west Plain: recorded at small swamp on Bogan River at Nyngan 8 Sep (AKM). Upper Western: very common at Mt Murchison HSD 31 Aug–7 Sep (GLC). Lower Western: widespread breeding at Willandra Lakes 14–20 Dec (WEB, IMcA). Major influx Dareton to Ivanhoe in Apr, huge flocks of thousands, coinciding with hatching of plague locusts; no breeding, numbers declined May; another major sustained influx in the region from 31 Aug, again coinciding with hatching of plague locusts, widespread breeding into Dec (JNH); exceptional numbers also reported northern Victoria (VBR).

Dusky Woodswallow *Artamus cyanopterus*Sydney region: 1 female found dead at Ku-ringgai Chase NP 19 Apr, now AM 0.58082 (RCn per AM). *ca* 12 at Beacon Hill, Sydney 14 May, 31 May, 15 Jun; 1 same place 18 Jun; several nesting in regenerating heath 24 Oct (LJH). South Coast: arrival Moruya

21 Sep (SM). Central Tableland: flocks ca 20 at Winmalee almost daily during May, tending NW, apparently on passage (NLK). Upper Western: uncommon at Mt Murchison HSD 27 Aug–7 Sep (GLC). Lower Western: ca 35 at Buronga STW 21 Jul, unusual winter record (JC); flock 120 at Dareton throughout Aug, in Belar woodland, feeding on fruits of *Exocarpus aphyllus*; rare in far SW (JNH).

Little Woodswallow *Artamus minor* Central-west Plain: 4 at a small swamp on Bogan River at Nyngan 8 Sep, with White-browed Woodswallows (AKM).

Pied Butcherbird *Cracticus nigrogularis* Hunter: 1 at Tomago 18 Jan (WPB); pair with 2 young at Shortland, Newcastle during Feb (AW). Recorded at Putty 7 Oct (J&NR).

Australian Magpie Gymnorhina tibicen Hunter (white-backed form): 1 at Elermore Vale, Newcastle 4 Oct (BB).

Pied Currawong Strepera graculina Central-west Slope: 1 at Bogan Gate 12 May (NWS). Riverina: recorded at Barham 9 Jun (EBT); none recorded at Griffith during winter (JB). Lord Howe Island: total ca 52 censused 5–16 May, in ca 20–30 groups, max 5 per group (BJK).

Grey Currawong Strepera versicolor Hunter: 2 near Bulga 30 Oct, observer's furthest N record (ARMcG). Lower Western (subsp melanoptera): recorded in mallee at Mungo NP 15 Dec and 5 km N of Mallee Cliffs NP 20 Dec (WEB, IMcA).

Australian Raven *Corvus coronoides* Mid-north Coast: 2 (male, female) at Rawdon Island, Wauchope in Sep, now AM O.58487, O.58488; female adult (curved oviduct) (per AM).

Forest Raven Corvus tasmanicus Northern Rivers: 1 at Dorrigo NP 5 Sep (GPC).
